# FAQ

## What does it mean to be fully vaccinated?

"Fully vaccinated" means having received both doses of an approved two-dose COVID-19 vaccine or one dose of a single-dose COVID-19 vaccine and at least 14 days have passed since the individual's final dose of COVID-19 vaccine. Approved COVID-19 vaccines are those authorized for use in the United States or those listed for emergency use by the World Health Organization.

### Does the requirement apply to those who have previously had COVID-19?

Yes, the CDC advises getting vaccinated even if you had a COVID-19 infection and have COVID antibodies, in order to help build lasting protection. Research has not yet shown how long you are protected from getting COVID-19 again after you recover from COVID-19.

### I'm not getting vaccinated. Does this mean I can't attend in person classes?

That's correct. Starting February 27 vaccination is required for in-person activities. If you are not vaccinated, we invite you to join us for our online classes and virtual events.

### How do I submit proof of vaccination?

- EMAIL: you may send a copy of your vaccination card via email to frontdesk@circusproject.org
- IN PERSON: if you are currently attending classes, you can show your vaccination card to the front desk before class begins on the first day, and they will make a note in your MindBody account.
- For Private Lessons, you will need to submit proof of vaccination via email, upon registering.

#### What types of vaccination proof are acceptable?

Appropriate documentation must include: documentation provided by a tribal, federal, state or local government or a health care provider, that includes an individual's name, date of birth, type of COVID-19 vaccination given, date or dates given depending on whether it is a one-dose or two-dose vaccine, and the name and location of the health care provider or site where the vaccine was administered.

Examples of appropriate documentation include: : a COVID-19 vaccination record card, a copy or digital picture of the vaccination record card, or a print-out from the Oregon Health Authority's immunization registry.

Falsifying Covid-19 vaccination documentation is a federal offense.

#### What do I do if I have a medical exemption?

Serious medical exemptions will be allowed. You will need to submit documentation from your health care provider to the student services manager by emailing <u>maia@thecircusproject.org</u>

#### What if I am taking online classes only?

You do not need to be vaccinated in order to take online classes. We encourage you to get a vaccine anyway, and you will need it if you would like to take in person classes one day.
