

ANNOUNCEMENT: REQUIREMENT FOR ALL STUDENTS ENROLLING FOR SPRING TERM TO HAVE PROOF OF VACCINATION DOCUMENTED IN THEIR ACCOUNTS PRIOR TO PRIVATE LESSONS, AND PRIOR TO OR DAY OF THEIR FIRST CLASS.

DATE DUE (for Proof of Vaccination) to participate in Spring Term: February 27th 2022

FAQ

What does it mean to be fully vaccinated?

“Fully vaccinated” means having received both doses of an approved two-dose COVID-19 vaccine or one dose of a single-dose COVID-19 vaccine and at least 14 days have passed since the individual’s final dose of COVID-19 vaccine. Approved COVID-19 vaccines are those authorized for use in the United States or those listed for emergency use by the World Health Organization.

Does the requirement apply to those who have previously had COVID-19?

Yes, the CDC advises getting vaccinated even if you had a COVID-19 infection and have COVID antibodies, in order to help build lasting protection. Research has not yet shown how long you are protected from getting COVID-19 again after you recover from COVID-19.

I’m not getting vaccinated. Does this mean I can’t attend in person classes?

That’s correct. Starting February 27 vaccination is required for in-person activities. If you are not vaccinated, we invite you to join us for our online classes and virtual events.

How do I submit proof of vaccination?

- EMAIL: you may send a copy of your vaccination card via email to frontdesk@circusproject.org
- IN PERSON: if you are currently attending classes, you can show your vaccination card to the front desk before class begins on the first day, and they will make a note in your MindBody account.
- For Private Lessons, you will need to submit proof of vaccination via email, upon registering.

What types of vaccination proof are acceptable?

Appropriate documentation must include: documentation provided by a tribal, federal, state or local government or a health care provider, that includes an individual's name, date of birth, type of COVID-19 vaccination given, date or dates given depending on whether it is a one-dose or two-dose vaccine, and the name and location of the health care provider or site where the vaccine was administered.

Examples of appropriate documentation include: : a COVID-19 vaccination record card, a copy or digital picture of the vaccination record card, or a print-out from the Oregon Health Authority's immunization registry.

Falsifying Covid-19 vaccination documentation is a federal offense.

What do I do if I have a medical exemption?

Serious medical exemptions will be allowed. You will need to submit documentation from your health care provider to the student services manager by emailing maia@thecircusproject.org

What if I am taking online classes only?

You do not need to be vaccinated in order to take online classes. We encourage you to get a vaccine anyway, and you will need it if you would like to take in person classes one day.
